Program connects and engages faculty/staff/alumni, and employer partners who are actively assisting students in reaching their career goals; goal is to educate everyone who is part of the program and provide them with resources they need so that they can have effective conversations with students they are mentoring/giving career advice to
 - b. Career Center created these Career Development Modules – Informational Interviewing, LinkedIn, Interviewing, Resume, Cover Letter
