- I. Background SSEI (student success for equity and inclusion)
 - a. Designed to bridge the gap in student services.
 - i. Attempting to boost retention and graduation rates among marginal groups.
 - 1. 1,943 students in this category
 - b. The office is growing with several new hires to assist students.
 - i. The office intends on being open 15 hrs. a day, 5 days a week (240 days of the year)
 - c. Bringing together 14 minority groups on campus that offer additional support services.
 - i. Academic advising
 - ii. Tutoring
 - iii. Mentoring
 - iv. Carrer counseling
 - v. Study skills workshops.
 - vi. Time management workshops
 - d. RISE
 - i. Partnered with synchrony.
 - ii. Faculty can refer students to the RISE program.
 - 1. Either 'At risk' or those wanting to explore scholarship and support services.
 - 2. Referral form can be found online or in the recent email announcement.
 - e. A member asks a question about midterm reports. Because faculty submit grades, is this information sent to SSEI, or does there need to be additional reporting?
 - i. Because the program runs year-round, the idea is to refer prior to midterms.
 - f. A member asks who the 1,950 students include?
 - i. First generation minority students.

- g. Marie asks how to increase participation in the services already available because any of those that are doing poorly are not seeking assistance or taking advantage of the numerous services that already exist.
 - i. Once the office becomes established, the goal is to proactively identify and approach those students in need.
 - ii. Gone goal is to determine the 'why' failure is occurring, then address the issues, and progress track to assist.
- h. ConCap is a high school program and now falls under the SSEI department.
 - i. Address students prior to attending UCONN.
